God Bless you all and I HOPE that Spring, will spring soon.

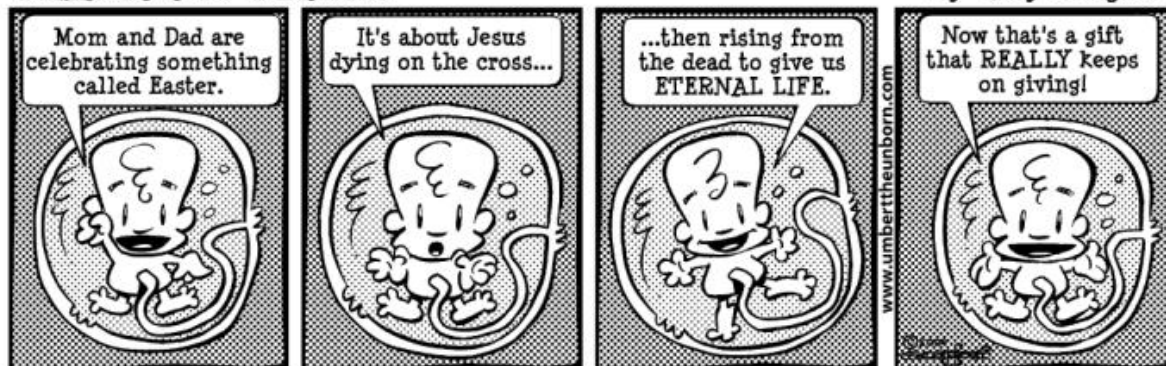

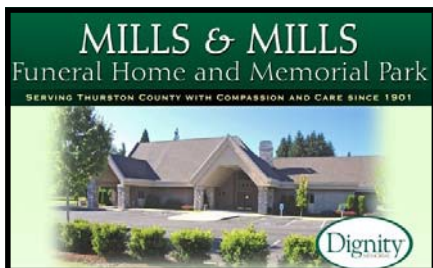

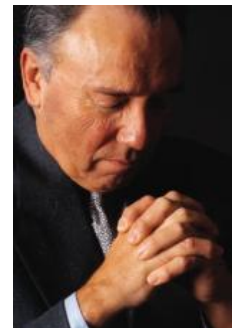

Fr. LEE PERRY
