

Medjugorje Diet - Current Results for Brother Ron DeGroot

I began following the Medjugorje Diet consisting of intermittent fasting coupled with prayer. I think the combination of fasting and prayer is important. As we got into a new way of washing hands I've been saying one "Our Father and one "Hail Mary" while I lather my hands with soap. I also find that I'm praying in other parts of my life as I have concentrated on the prayer portion of the diet.

I weighed 258 when I began and have fasted on Wednesday and Friday each week since mid-February. I eat as many as three stalks of celery with either peanut butter or cheese spread for breakfast, lunch and dinner on my fast days. I have gotten to look forward to celery and peanut butter but I do throw in salad once a day or so.

Years ago my doctor suggested that I forgo Thousand Island dressing and either eat my salad plain or with oil

and vinegar. That didn't sound good to me then but I now really enjoy both undressed salad or salad with oil and vinegar. I've now been on the diet for 4 ½ months and have lost 39 pounds and I have lowered my A1C from 7 ½ to 6. I have gotten off one of my diabetes meds and the Doc tells me if I lower it again over the current three months I might get off the other diabetes med as well. Prior to my weight loss I had neuropathy in both feet. Today I no longer have it in my left foot and the right foot has improved 50%.

If you are overweight I encourage you to try this diet. You may find that this is good approach.
