

120 people joined us in this celebration at the hall. Finger food was provided by Sam Pellegrino.

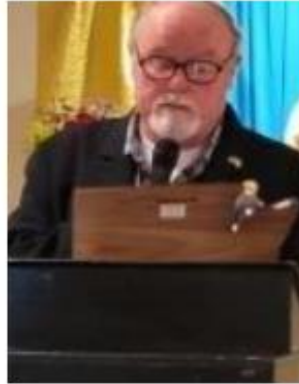

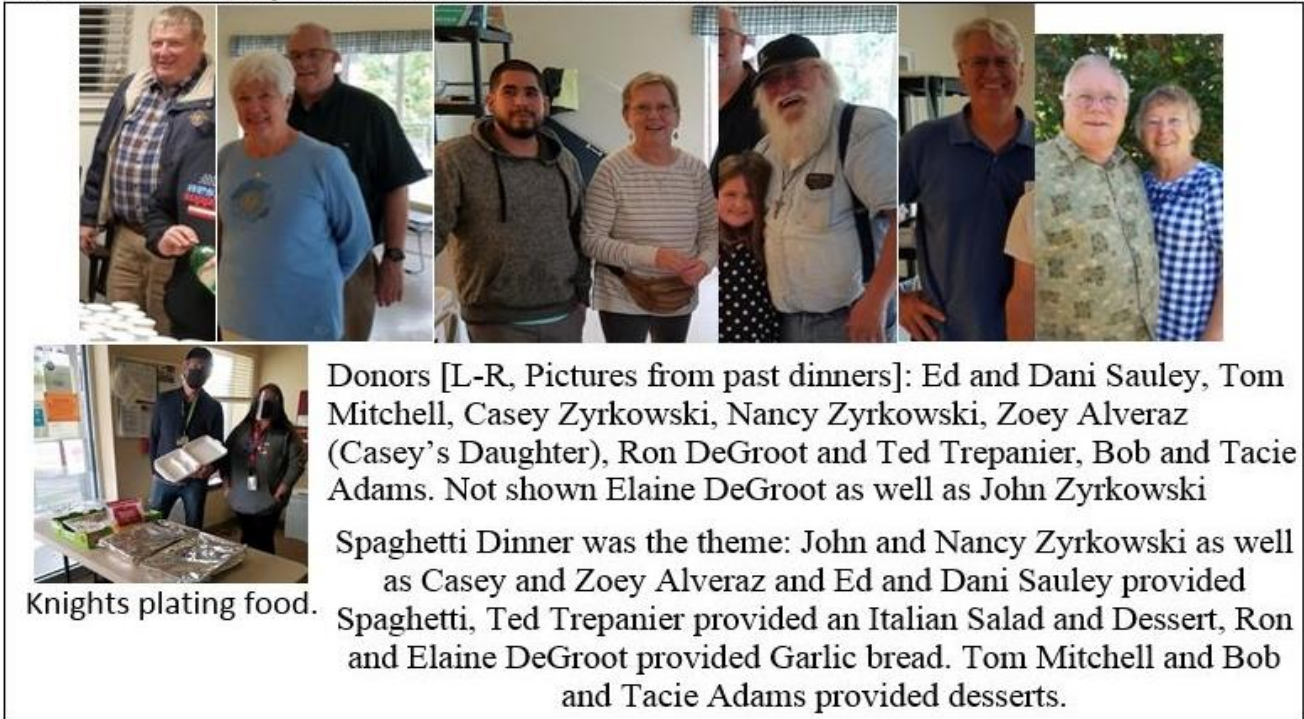

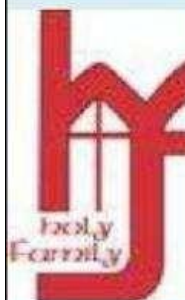
